Schools should encourage parents to arrange with the district Nutrition Services Department for catering class parties/celebrations to ensure food safety and maximize the ability of the district Nutrition Services Department to serve healthy and appealing meals.

The school district should offer and promote healthy food and beverage products at all school sponsored events.

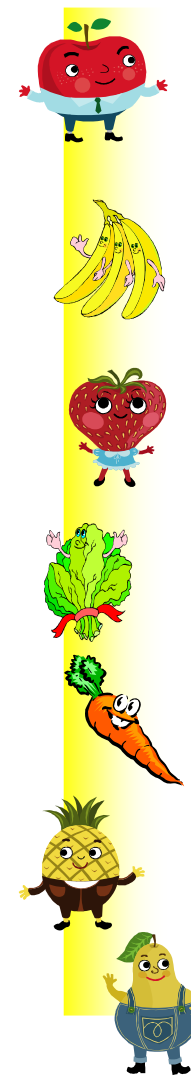
